# Memorial Tree Planting Program

The Westmont Park District is proud to administer a Memorial Tree Planting Program. Many varieties of trees can be purchased and planted in the park of your choice.

Trees can be purchased as a gift for a friend, for yourself or in memory of a loved one. A tree can also be purchased for a newborn to commemorate their birth year, and your family can watch as both grow through the years!

All trees purchased through the Memorial Tree Planting Program consist of tree planting, the mounting of a permanent plaque and a certificate of planting issued to the donating party. Trees can be purchased at any time throughout the year. Planting will be done in Spring and Fall.

All trees are guaranteed to live for 20 years. In the event that a tree dies, a new tree (same variety & size as originally planted) will be installed by the Park District.

The trees available through the Memorial Tree Planting Program are listed below:

## *Shade Trees*

General Characteristics: tall, deciduous trees with a large canopy, often exceeding 45 feet in height.

## *Evergreen Trees*

General Characteristics: evergreens with needles which remain year-round, becoming large, beautiful specimens.

## *Ornamental Trees*

General Characteristics: beautiful, showy flowers/fruit, interesting branch forms and attractive fall color. Available in 2" diameter and 7' tall clump.
